Clinical senior lecturer in Paedia Rheum, Division of Musculoskeletal and Dermatological Sciences, University of Manchester, UK.

Janet has a particular interest in models of care for adolescents with chronic conditions that support young people's emerging capacity for self-management, that ensure appropriate health risk assessment, support transition to adult health care, adherence to treatment and engagement with other health care services.
